All artworks must fall within the stated guidelines and convey the artists’ interpretation and spirit of this exhibit.

Art Drop-Off Pick-Up: All artwork must be dropped off and picked up at the Grange Hall Cultural Center, 317 Howard Avenue, Waterbury Center, Vermont 05677 between the hours of 5-7pm on designated dates. *All other arrangements are the responsibility of the artist and subject to a GHCC handling fee, at GHCC’s discretion.*

EXHIBITION INFORMATION

All artwork will hang in the Upstairs Hall at the Grange Hall Cultural Center at 317 Howard Avenue, Waterbury Center, Vermont and be available for viewing during regular public activity or by appointment.

DISPLAY

Artists must supply hanging equipment for artwork. GHCC will work with the artist to arrange for appropriate hanging application, so as to protect both the facility and the artwork’s integrity.

GHCC reserves the right to refuse to display any works deemed inappropriate for any reason, at any time.

MAXIMUM SIZE ALLOWANCES

Due to the sizes of exhibition space, the sizes of work cannot exceed the following dimensions:

Space #4 may have multiple pieces hanging.

SALES

- Grange Hall Cultural Center will retain 20% commission on any work sold during the exhibition.
- The Grange Hall Cultural Center will receive 15% from the Artist on any outside sales or commissions (production products, commissioned pieces, etc.) resulting from this exhibition through the holiday season (12/31/17).
- All commissioned funds will benefit the Grange Hall Cultural Center Renovation/Preservation Fund.

Artist assumes all responsibility for insuring his/her own artwork.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Submit email to grangehallcc@gmail.com no later than September 1.

Your email must contain:

- 1) "Fabric of Our Lives" as the subject line.
- 2) Artwork Submission Form, completed (no omissions). One for each work.
- 3) Digital images of artwork submitted. Images must be a .jpg file and include the .jpg filename extension. Each image must be less than 3MB in file size. We suggest a resolution of 300 DPI and image dimensions of no larger than 6 inches (or 1800px) on the longest side. Image files should be named in the following manner: "Lastname.Firstname_Title.jpg" (full image); "Lastname.Firstname_TitleDetail.jpg" (detail). Examples: Smith.Jane_BlueQuilt.jpg or Smith.Jane_BlueQuilt.Detail.jpg
- 4) Brief artist statement (75 words maximum for each piece, included in the body of the e-mail) about how each piece submitted relates to the theme of the show as described above. A longer statement (300 words maximum), may be submitted later for exhibition signage.
